## **Rep. Steffen and Colleagues Reveal Red Tape Review**

*Assembly Republican Majority Announces Initiative to Cut Government Red Tape*

**Madison-** This week State Representative David Steffen (R-Howard) joined members of the Assembly Republican majority in announcing the Red Tape Review initiative. Last session, the Right the Rules project began which focused on eliminating outdated and burdensome regulations in Wisconsin's Administrative Code. This initiative will continue the effort to review all 1,768 chapters in the Administrative Code.

"Wisconsin's Administrative Code should be designed to advance our citizens and our businesses. Instead, many of these rules have simply added to government red tape. I look forward to working with my colleagues to review these rules, cut the red tape, and create a leaner more efficient government," said Rep. Steffen.

Public input is a key part of this review process. Prior to a press conference at the State Capitol, a series of round table sessions were held in Neenah, Pewaukee, Rothschild, and Altoona to unveil the Red Tape Review.

"Last session, over 300 chapters were reviewed and 76 pages were cut from the Administrative Code. Through oversight and review we can ensure that the rules we have on the books are relevant and do not create unnecessary obstacles for business or citizens," said Rep. Steffen.
