## **Rep. Steffen Receives Municipal Champion Award**

**Madison-** State Representative David Steffen (R-Howard) was honored by the Wisconsin League of Municipalities with their Municipal Champion recognition for his efforts during the 2015-16 legislative session. The distinguished recognition is reserved for legislators who have dedicated themselves to supporting Wisconsin municipalities by authoring and supporting legislation aimed at advancing and protecting municipal powers and resources.

“I served as a village trustee for eight years before becoming a state representative. That experience as a local official has fostered my deep appreciation for the importance our municipalities play in serving the residents of Wisconsin. Now, as a state representative, I have had the privilege to work on legislation that protects and advances the role of municipalities. I am truly honored by this award, which reflects my strong support for local leadership,” said Rep. Steffen.

The League cited Rep. Steffen’s consistent support of legislation aimed at helping municipalities, his consistent opposition of legislation aimed at preempting local powers, and specific legislation he authored as reasons making him deserving of this recognition. This session Rep. Steffen authored bills to return excess Lambeau Stadium sales tax to Brown County and its municipalities, as well as a bill to provide local communities additional options in obtaining necessary liquor licenses.
