Rep. Steffen Responds to Evers' Veto of Tax-Free Retirement

Madison, WI – State Representative David Steffen (R-Howard), lead author of Wisconsin's tax-free retirement proposal, released the following statement in response to Governor Evers' recent veto of the tax-cut.

"In the aftermath of historic inflation, Governor Evers continues to support higher taxes in Wisconsin. His action could not be more out of touch. Thanks to his veto, retirees on average will pay \$1,582 more in 2024 taxes.

"This is the third tax-free retirement proposal I've authored this session—a testament to mine and the Legislature's good-faith effort to negotiate and find middle ground. Unfortunately, the Governor would rather continue to play politics at the very real expense of Wisconsinites.

"Through his veto, Evers has in essence delivered a shocking and shameful message: retirees don't need to keep more of their own money, they just need more government. I couldn't be in greater disagreement with the Governor's sentiment and I couldn't be more disappointed for the residents of Wisconsin," said Rep. Steffen.
