Calls on Attorney General to assist Milwaukee in Placement of Sex Offenders

Milwaukee – Rep. Josh Zepnick today called on outgoing Attorney General JB Van Hollen to come to work and help Milwaukee find a solution on the placement of sex offenders.

“Instead of spending time fighting whether or not people should be allowed to be married, Attorney General Van Hollen should focus on the actual problems facing Wisconsin. Milwaukee is struggling and acting as a dumping ground for Wisconsin’s Sex Offenders. This is a problem that needs to be addressed.

“Over the past series of sessions, the legislature has offered a couple of bipartisan solutions. The safe placement and relocation of sex offenders isn’t a partisan issue, it’s a safety and fairness issue. AG Van Hollen should work with the City of Milwaukee, to help come up with a solution to this public safety issue. In the upcoming legislative session, I plan on working towards creating a more equitable solution to this problem.
