Governor Walker Signs Two Rep. Hutton Bills into Law

MADISON – This week, Governor Walker signed into law the monumental State Government Budget Accountability bill, Senate Bill 407, and also the Juvenile Compact bill, Assembly Bill 627, both authored by Rep. Hutton (R-Brookfield).

“I want to thank Governor Walker for signing the Budget Accountability for State Expenditures (BASE) bill into law” said Rep. Hutton. “This legislation is a critical tool that will promote transparency and help address spending in our agencies. As we discuss funding priorities and programs, it is important that we consider every option to make sure we are putting the taxpayers first.”

The State Government Budget Accountability Bill, Senate Bill 407, requires state agencies to submit, along with their initial budget requests, requests with 0% increase in their previous budget and 5% decrease in their previous budget as part of their biennial budget requests.

In addition, Assembly Bill 627, the Interstate Compact bill, was signed into law. Juveniles that have been adjudicated delinquent for sex offenses that are coming to Wisconsin would now be required to register with the state sex offender registry. Assembly Bill 627 repeals the Interstate Compact on Juveniles now that all states have accepted the Interstate Compact on Juveniles. This change removes outdated policies and procedures to provide clarity for the Department of Corrections. Further, it corrects an oversight when Wisconsin adopted this compact in 2005.
