Rep. Sanfelippo Takes Oath of Office, Ready to Serve the 15th Assembly District

Madison... Former small business owner and Milwaukee County Board Supervisor, Joe Sanfelippo (R-West Allis) was sworn into the 101st Wisconsin State Legislature on Monday. Representative Sanfelippo will use his local government and private sector experiences to help improve Wisconsin's economy and grow jobs.

"It is an incredible honor to be able to take the oath of office as a public servant of the 15th Assembly District," said Sanfelippo. "There are distinct challenges to tackle this coming session, and I am ready to get to work enacting policies that will benefit the families, individuals and businesses in my district."

Previously, Rep. Sanfelippo founded and operated a 60-employee landscaping business for twenty-five years. He is currently serving his second term on the Milwaukee County Board.

"My goal this session is to pursue more reforms that lets Wisconsin taxpayers keep more of their hard-earned money, and to streamline government operations."
