voted against exempting political crimes of corruption and abuse of power from John Doe investigations

voted to delay any changes to Wisconsin's campaign finance laws until after the next election so that incumbents would not have an unfair advantage

Voted N on TABLE AMENDMENT on 10/21/2015 (AB 387 AA 8 OFFERED BY BARNES REG Session)

voted against dismantling the non-partisan Government Accountability Board and against replacing it with toothless commissions composed of partisan political appointees

voted to give shareholders the right to object to corporate political donations

voted in favor of a plan to take partisan politics out of the redistricting process because voters should choose their elected officials, not the other way around
