Rep. Vorpapel Statement Following State of the State Address

Madison—Today, State Representative Tyler Vorpapel (R-Plymouth) issued this statement following Governor Walker’s State of the State Address:

“I ran for office last fall to continue Governor Walker’s agenda of lowering taxes, reforming government, and help give more Wisconsinites the ability to find work. I am pleased to see that the Assembly [Republican Forward Agenda](#), which our caucus released in October, aligns well with Governor Walker’s goals.

“By focusing on our priorities to create jobs, develop the workforce, improve education, reform government, and invest in our infrastructure we can improve our economy and everyone’s way of life.

“The state of our future is bright, just last month the unemployment rate hit its lowest since 2008 at 5.2%, this is paired with Wisconsin leading the Midwest for private sector job growth.
