Rep. Plumer and Assembly Pass Tax Relief for the Middle Class and Retirees in Wisconsin – Governor Evers Threatens Veto

MADISON, WI – Today on the floor, Rep. Plumer and the Assembly passed a middle class tax cut, significant tax relief for Wisconsin retirees, and protections for residents of the state from massive tax increases in the future:

“Our focus in the Legislature hasn’t changed. Fund the important priorities for Wisconsin like education, roads, mental health, and affordable healthcare and return our historic surplus to taxpayers through a significant middle-class tax cut.

“The action we took in the Assembly today provides the average filer over \$770 in savings, eliminates taxes on retirement income, and amends our constitution to require a 2/3 super-majority vote to raise taxes in the future.

”After initially signaling that he was open to the idea, it’s a shame that **Governor Evers threatens to once again prevent tax relief from reaching Wisconsin’s middle class families.** While we certainly hope he doesn’t follow through on it, **his veto would also prevent retirees and seniors from seeing their retirement income become tax-free.**

“The legislation now heads to the Wisconsin Senate for consideration.”
