HEBL VOICES CONSTITUENTS CONCERNS ABOUT US-51 INTERSECTION

MADISON - State Representative Gary Hebl (D-46th Assembly District) announced Friday that temporary traffic signals will be installed at US-51 and Hoepker Road on Madison's northeast side in advance of the intersection's upcoming reconstruction.

"It is imperative that we do whatever is necessary to make our roads safe for everyone," Hebl said. "I am pleased to hear that the Department of Transportation is responding to the concerns local residents and I have voiced to make sure this intersection is safe for commuters."

According to DOT officials, the planned intersection reconstruction, which will be completed within two years, will include new turn lanes, safety medians and signals.

A public information meeting is scheduled to be held from 5-8 p.m., on Wednesday, Oct. 8, 2008 at the Burke Town Hall, 5365 Reiner Road.
