Rep. Hebl's "Helpful Hints"

Cell phones now eligible for "No Call List"

Everyone has had this experience. You come home after a long day of work, sit down at the table for dinner with your family, and the phone starts ringing. We've all been through it before, we all know the frustration, have dealt with the hassle and felt the annoyance.

It used to be that this type of annoyance happened every night, but 6 years ago Wisconsin launched the "No Call List" to protect the people of this state from the nearly constant harassment from telemarketers. Today, this hassle protection is also available for your cell phone. To get this protection, however, you must re-register your phone numbers every 2 years.

Registering for the "No Call List" is simple. All you need to do is go to nocall.wisconsin.gov or call 1-(866)-9NO-CALL (1-(866)-966-2255) to register your land-line or cell phone numbers. Numbers registered by May 31 will be on the quarterly list sent to telemarketers in July. The service is free and consumers can sign up 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

A good trick to remembering to re-registering on the "No Call List" is to re-register on a specific day every time, such as your birthday or St. Patrick's Day. This way, re-registering will be easier to remember and you will avoid a lapse in your coverage.
