**REP. GARY HEBL COMMENTS ON CONDITION OF STATE’S ROADS, TRAILS**

(MADISON) – Today State Rep. Gary Hebl (D-Sun Prairie) shared his concern about the current state of disrepair that we see in Wisconsin’s roads and bike trails.

“It is no secret that the condition of roads in Wisconsin’s is disgraceful,” Hebl said. “But I also had a constituent recently point out what a sad state our bike trails are in as well. We cannot allow this to continue. We simply must find the funds to fix our crumbling roads and trails.”

“Wisconsin’s tourism industry has long been the bedrock of our state’s economy,” Hebl continued. “If we can’t fund basic needs of our own citizens, how can we entice people from other regions to visit us? Instead we have examples of our own citizens traveling to neighboring states because those states are actually able to provide the level of upkeep to their roads and trails that people expect. Wisconsin must be able to keep up.”

“It saddens me to see how far the conditions of our trails and roads have fallen. The bottom line is that if we can’t find funding for these areas, we suffer on two fronts- not only will they remain in their current sorry state, but because of their condition, we will lose money on those who refuse to use them and go elsewhere. Figuring out how to fund these repairs must be made a priority in the upcoming legislative session.”
