(Madison)...State Representative Dave Murphy (R-Greenville) made the following statement after Governor Walker's 2015 State of the State Address:

"I am excited to work with Governor Walker to build on the progress that Wisconsin has made over the last four years. Governor Walker's bold leadership and actions align with the Assembly Republican's Forward Agenda to make government more efficient and accountable to the taxpayers."

"Property tax relief is a top priority of mine. Last session, we invested \$500 million in property tax relief resulting in taxpayers seeing lower bills than they did in 2010. We will continue to cut taxes and lower the property tax burden this session."
