Rep. Stuck – Disappointed in Delay to Highway 10/441 Construction in the Fox Cities

MADISON – Following yesterday’s announcement that completion of the Highway 10/441 project in the Fox Cities would be delayed, possibly until 2022, two years behind schedule, Rep. Amanda Stuck issued the following statement:

“I am disappointed that Governor Walker and Republican Legislators kicked the can down the road on vital funding for our transportation infrastructure. The Governor put forward a plan to borrow record sums to pay for our roads and the Republicans slashed that amount significantly, while failing to put forward a sustainable solution for the future of transportation funding,” stated Rep. Stuck.

“As a result of these short-sighted decisions, we not only have significant borrowing and record debt payments for our roads, but now we won’t even complete the projects already in progress on time. The Highway 10-441 project in my district is a major effort to improve traffic flow and safety on an outdated bridge and interchange,” said Rep. Stuck. “Despite assurances from Republican Legislators in the area who voted for the budget, stating that this project is too important, we are now facing the consequences here in the Fox Cities. By delaying this project, business owners and constituents in my district and in the entire surrounding Fox Valley will bear the brunt of these cuts and negative impacts from the delay.”

“I hope that my colleagues will stand up to their caucus members and work to make sure that this vital project to the Fox Cities isn’t delayed. It is time that the State of Wisconsin take a serious look at the future of our transportation infrastructure,” stated Rep. Stuck. “This is just the first of many negative impacts from kicking the can down the road and I fear that we will be dealing with these consequences for years to come.”
