Rep. Stuck sworn in to State Legislature

MADISON – Today Rep. Stuck (D - Appleton) was sworn in as a State Representative for the 102nd Wisconsin State Legislature. Rep. Stuck was officially welcomed to the legislature at an Inauguration ceremony in the State Capitol.

“It is my great honor to represent the people of the 57th Assembly District,” stated Rep. Stuck. “I’m looking forward to rolling up my sleeves as we work to create jobs and promote a strong Wisconsin economy. Supporting a strong K-12, technical college and university system has to be a top priority as we look to create a well-trained and well-educated workforce. Rep. Amanda Stuck is a lifelong resident of Appleton. She worked her way through college at the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh, through school serving in AmeriCorps at Habitat for Humanity and the Red Cross, and as a Rural Mail Carrier. Stuck earned her Master’s in Public Administration from UW-Oshkosh and worked for former Congressman Steve Kagen and the Appleton Housing Authority. Stuck is an active volunteer, serving on the Boards of the Fox Cities Community Council and the Fox Valley Humane Association, as well as the United Way 211 Advisory Committee and in her children’s schools.
