**Economic Opportunity Agenda: 15 Bills for 2015**

Last week my democratic colleagues and I announced our Economic Opportunity Agenda: 15 Bills for 2015, a package of legislation that will help restore economic opportunities for all of Wisconsin's workers, students, and families. Our proposals would raise wages, create family supporting jobs, and grow Wisconsin's middle class. I look forward to working to advance these proposals and helping to ensure they receive the strong bipartisan support they deserve.

Together with Representative Eric Genrich from Green Bay, I am leading efforts to pass a "Buy Wisconsin" bill, as part of the "15 Bills for 2015" package. The Buy Wisconsin bill encourages state and local governments to buy materials and services from Wisconsin-based businesses by setting minimum contracting goals directing that not less than 20% of a fiscal year's purchases be procured from Wisconsin-based businesses. This is a bold, yet achievable, target that will have a dramatic impact on Wisconsin's economy.
