Assembly Votes to Reform Wisconsin's John Doe Law

Madison—Representative Mike Kuglitsch (R-New Berlin) released the following statement after voting in favor of AB 68, the John Doe Reform Bill:

“After years of uncertainty and abuse, I am pleased to see this legislation take another step in the right direction. We must continue to examine all areas of our statutes and pledge that all Wisconsinites are granted their given rights under our Constitution.

“As Wisconsinites and Americans, we all deserve due process of the law with proper judicial oversight and the accountability of a full time judge. These reforms guarantee that. The new timeline, the elimination of secrecy orders, and the overall procedures that are outlined in Assembly Bill 68, provide greater transparency for all Wisconsinites.

“I understand how important a John Doe investigation can be, especially when testimony is hard to obtain. However, we should still expect the proper checks and balances from our Government. This bill does that by curbing the absurd power given to prosecutors investigating Wisconsinites.”
