Rep. Spiros Reacts to the State of the State Address

Madison – Representative John Spiros (R-Marshfield) issued the following statement in response to the Governor’s State of the State Address before a joint session of the Wisconsin State Legislature:

“It is astonishing that the Governor can stand in front of the entire state and take credit for work he has not done. Responsible, Republican-authored budgets and tax cuts are the reason Wisconsin is in the strong fiscal position that it is, not the anti-small business, big spending policies that the Governor favors.
