Assembly Passes Spiros Bills

Madison – Today, the Wisconsin State Assembly passed two bills authored by Representative John Spiros (R-Marshfield).

Assembly Bill 344 lengthens the time during which tax increments may be allocated and expenditures for project costs may be made for Tax Incremental District Number One in the village of Weston. “This is a great bill for the Village of Weston and will help promote economic development in the area.” Spiros said. “I was happy to work on legislation that will have a positive impact in our district and I am proud that the Assembly came together to support and pass this bill.”

The Assembly also passed Assembly Bill 223 which would change the statute of limitations on property damage in motor vehicle claims to three years and on claims in which a death is caused arising from a motor vehicle accident to two years. “Making these changes will enhance the legal process, ensure that evidence related to a motor-vehicle claim is available, and make sure that claims be processed in a timely manner,” stated Spiros. “This bill will also bring us more in line with the majority of states in our country.”

Both bills will be taken up in the Senate before being presented to the Governor for his signature.
