Rep. Spiros Votes for Middle Class Tax Cut

Madison – Today, Representative John Spiros (*R – Marshfield*) voted to support a tax cut that would return \$340 million to the hardworking people of Wisconsin. The Middle Class Tax Cut bill advanced out of the Assembly today.

“When I was first elected to the State Assembly, I promised to cut taxes,” said Rep. Spiros. “The state has cut taxes by \$8 billion since 2011, and I’m proud that we’re able to reduce the tax burden on families once again.”

The Middle Class Tax Cut bill provides \$340 million in tax relief to individuals making less than \$100,000 and families earning \$150,000 or less. According to projections from the nonpartisan Legislative Fiscal Bureau, the median income family filing jointly would see a \$310 reduction in net taxes. Three-quarters of the tax cut benefit goes to filers making between \$30,000 and \$100,000.

“I was encouraged to see Governor Evers’ campaign promise to cut taxes on the middle class,” said Rep. Spiros. “Our constituents want to see us working together in a bipartisan manner, and I hope we are able to do that by getting this tax cut passed and signed into law.”

Assembly Bill 4 now moves to the Wisconsin State Senate to be considered before heading to the governor’s desk to be signed into law.
