You Deserve More

We wake up early, make coffee and head to work. Later we might have a get together with some friends or head to our kid's sporting event before doing it all over again the next day. These things may seem small but they are important to us. People all over the state work extremely hard for their money and for themselves and taxes and having a pre-existing condition shouldn't get in their way. We have enough to worry about with the responsibilities in our daily lives.

On Wednesday January 17th my colleagues and I were proud to introduce a tax cut for the hard working middle class families. \$340 million in tax relief is on its way in 2020 if we can muster bipartisan support to lessen the burdens a little bit.

These proposed tax reductions are targeted to individuals making less than \$100,000 and families earning \$150,000 or less. This will have a huge impact in our district seeing as many of us make below these numbers. The nonpartisan Legislative Fiscal Bureau projects the median income family filing jointly would see a \$310 reduction in net taxes.

Additionally, something that has weighed on my mind heavily since 2017 is the issue of protecting those who have pre-existing conditions. In that year I voted to support a bill that would protect people even if the Federal Government did not. Unfortunately that bill did not pass the Senate. That's why the very first bill that will be voted on in the Assembly this year protects those with these conditions from being charged higher rates and I am a proud co-sponsor of this bill.

We can't choose what ails us. Even the best of us can have Diabetes, mental health issues, or serious heart conditions. But these ailments should never stop us from pursuing our goals.

I'm excited to see what this new legislative session brings and I look forward to being the voice of Western Wisconsin and the people of the 92nd district.
