



## DOYLE TO JOIN GOVERNOR AT THE EXECUTIVE RESIDENCE

*Tailgate party for bi-partisan group*

Representative Steve Doyle (D-Onalaska) has been invited to the Governor's residence to help cheer on the Wisconsin Badgers against Utah State on Saturday, September 15th. "The Badgers need to get on track to repeat as Big Ten Champions, so I'm excited to be part of the festivities," said Doyle. "The Governor has invited a bipartisan group of legislators to the Executive Residence to join together for a tailgate party, and my wife and I are pleased to be included," added Doyle.
