More Taxes, More Problems

Madison, WI- Today, State Representative Scott Allen (R- Waukesha) is disheartened to see that the FY 2023-2025 budget has been hijacked by Governor Evers via a partial veto and has released the following statement:

“I have long championed the fight to lower taxes for working-class Americans,” said Rep. Allen. “Why should those efforts be undone at the stroke of a pen?”
