## **Van Roy Says Get On the Bus!**

*Partnership for Prescription Assistance Express to Stop in Green Bay*

**MADISON** - According to Rep. Karl Van Roy (R-Howard), the Partnership for Prescription Assistance "Help is Here" Express will be stopping in Green Bay next week. The express is a bus equipped with computers, cell phones and knowledgeable assistants who help people with registering for prescription drug programs. It will be in Green Bay on April 19 from 10am-noon at the New Community Center on 622 Bodart Street, Green Bay, WI 54301.

"Getting on the bus means getting access to the people and equipment who can help you find the prescription drug program that fits your needs," said Van Roy. "You may qualify for one of more than 475 public or private programs, many of which offer free or deeply discounted prescription drugs."

The Partnership for Prescription Assistance "Help is Here" Express is a grassroots project aimed at helping patients obtain prescription drugs by registering for the plan that is best for them. More than 1,300 organizations, including the American Academy of Family Physicians, the National Alliance for Hispanic Health, the National Medical Association, and the United Way are all working with the program to help spread the word and assist people with registration.

"The event is free, and anybody can attend to see if they are eligible," Van Roy explained. "The express is a convenient way to become more educated about prescription drug programs so you can take control of your own health care decisions."
