## **VAN ROY TO INTRODUCE LEGISLATION BANNING CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS DURING STATE CONTRACTING**

**Madison...** In the wake of enduring Doyle Travel Scandal, State Representative Karl Van Roy (R-Howard) says that he will introduce legislation placing a gubernatorial campaign contribution moratorium on companies who are competing for state contracts. Van Roy's proposal comes after a Madison TV station discovered that Doyle had awarded a lucrative state contract to a major contributor after an independent committee had recommended a different firm.

"What Doyle did throws a shadow over the Office of the Governor and the State of Wisconsin," said Van Roy. "This is Green Bay, not Chicago, and we don't accept even the appearance of corruption here."

Van Roy says he is introducing this legislation at the request of his constituents at Chamber's

Van Roy's contribution moratorium will mirror a proposal from Congressman Mark Green and will prohibit campaign contributions to a governor's campaign from any employee, director, or owner of a company that has submitted a bid in response to a Request for Proposal (RFP). Van Roy says that his proposal will allow an exception for employees who would be prohibited from contributing for 12 straight months.
