Assembly Bill 194 Passes the Assembly – Again
Rep. Danou Pleased to See Full Inclusion of Crossbow in Wisconsin

MADISON - Rep. Chris Danou (D-Trempealeau) released the following statement regarding the introduction of the passage of Assembly Bill 194:

“I was thrilled when AB 194 unanimously passed in the Assembly this past June. It’s not every day we see a bill pass 95-0 with 52 co-sponsors from across the state on both sides of the aisle. I think that kind of bipartisan support speaks volumes to the merit of this bill.

“Even with a minimal amendment from the Senate, I still believe this bill achieves its goal of getting more hunters into the woods. AB 194 expands hunting options for men, women and children of all ages and abilities to participate in our hunting traditions. This bill made its way through the legislative process by bringing everyone together, hearing both sides and working towards a compromise.

“I am proud to be the lead Democratic author of AB 194 and I want to thank everyone who was involved with making this common-sense bill a reality.
