Rep. Rodriguez Responds to the Budget Address

MADISON – State Representative Jessie Rodriguez (R-Franklin) welcomed the unveiling of Governor Walker’s 2015-2017 state budget. In his third budget address, the governor laid out a blueprint outlining state spending for the next two years that legislators will begin to consider.

“Tonight, Governor Walker laid out a conservative plan to continue moving Wisconsin forward,” said Rodriguez. “This is my first state budget and I’m excited to see it through the entire process.”

Within the budget the governor proposed plans for the UW System, property tax reductions, workforce readiness programs, and funding for the Milwaukee Bucks Arena.

The workforce readiness programs that he’s proposing will include a tuition freeze for the technical colleges, aimed at students seeking training in high-demand occupations.

“It is important that people have access to family supporting jobs that work to strengthen our economy,” said Rodriguez. “These initiatives will prepare our workforce for the present and future.”

“The governor has provided the legislature with a great starting point. Now it is time to discuss the best course of action for the residents in our district and across the state,” concluded Rodriguez.
