## **Rep. Rodriguez Applauds Governor's 2015 State of the State Address**

**MADISON** – State Representative Jessie Rodriguez (R-Franklin) released the following statement after Governor Walker's 2015 State of the State speech at a joint session of the legislature on Tuesday evening:

“The plan outlined by Gov. Walker tonight continues to move Wisconsin forward, and will help pave the path to prosperity for future generations in our great state. His plan includes initiatives to continue strong job growth, reduce taxes, promote freedom from government dependence and address school accountability.

“Unemployment has fallen to 5.2% as of November 2014, the lowest rate since 2008, and Wisconsin led the Midwest for private sector job growth that month. Forbes magazine recently ranked Wisconsin first in the Midwest for projected job growth.

“The Governor's priorities are closely aligned with the Assembly Republican Forward Agenda that was released last October. Over the past four years, Republicans have reduced taxes by roughly \$2 billion, allowing families to keep more of their hard earned money and make spending decisions based on what is right for their family.

“I'm looking forward to working with my colleagues in the Assembly and Senate; working together, we can continue moving Wisconsin forward.”
