Vruwink Appointed to Wisconsin Educational Communications Board

State Representative Amy Sue Vruwink (D-Milladore) issued the following statement after her appointment to the Wisconsin Educational Communications Board was approved by Assembly Speaker Jeff Fitzgerald.

The Wisconsin Educational Communications Board (ECB) is a state agency that guarantees public radio, television programs, and services are made available throughout Wisconsin to students, parents, and administrators. The agency is responsible for ensuring that the programs and services mirror the educational and cultural needs of Wisconsin's residents.

"I'm honored by the opportunity to take an active role in this board, which plays a vital role in providing access to educational programming, informational news, and access to emergency alerts, all of which are very important to Central Wisconsin and the rest of the state," Vruwink said.

Among the services the ECB manages are Wisconsin Public Radio, Milwaukee Public Television, and Wisconsin Public Television. The ECB is also responsible for maintaining programs including the NOAA Weather Radio All Hazards and the Amber Alert Network.
