### Legislative and Congressional Redistricting

#### Motion:

Move to adopt the provisions of Senate Bill (SB) 13 [LRB 0922/1].

Require that: (a) legislative and congressional districts be redrawn under specified standards; (b) the Legislative Reference Bureau (LRB) prepare the redistricting plan; (c) the LRB be strictly nonpartisan in preparing the redistricting plan; (d) no district may be drawn in order to favor a political party, an elected incumbent, or, except as legally required, to increase or decrease the voting strength of a language or racial minority group; (e) in preparing the redistricting plan, the LRB not utilize residence addresses of incumbents, political party membership of registered voters, election results, or, generally, demographic information; (f) a Redistricting Advisory Commission be created no later than February 15<sup>th</sup> of the first year following each decennial federal census composed of five commission members including one appointed by each of the following legislative leaders: (1) the Speaker of the Assembly; (2) the Minority Leader of the Assembly; (3) the Majority Leader of the Senate; and (4) the Minority Leader of the Senate; (g) the Commission provide guidance to the LRB regarding any aspect of developing the redistricting plan for which no clear guidance is provided under SB 13; (h) the Commission conduct at least three public hearings on any LRB redistricting bill and submit a report to the Legislature summarizing information and testimony received by the Commission during these public hearings; (i) the Legislature debate any LRB redistricting bill under the procedure developed in SB 13; and (j) in any subsequent legal challenge, the Legislature would have the burden of justifying any variance in excess of: (1) 10% between the applicable ideal district population and the population of the relevant Senate or Assembly district; and (2) 1% between the applicable ideal district population and the population of the relevant congressional district.
