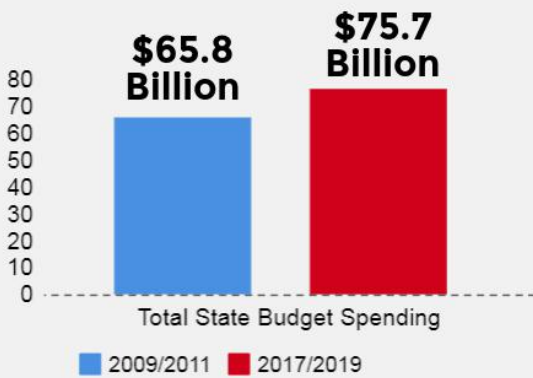


How Gov. Walker's Budget is Rigged Against Wisconsin Families

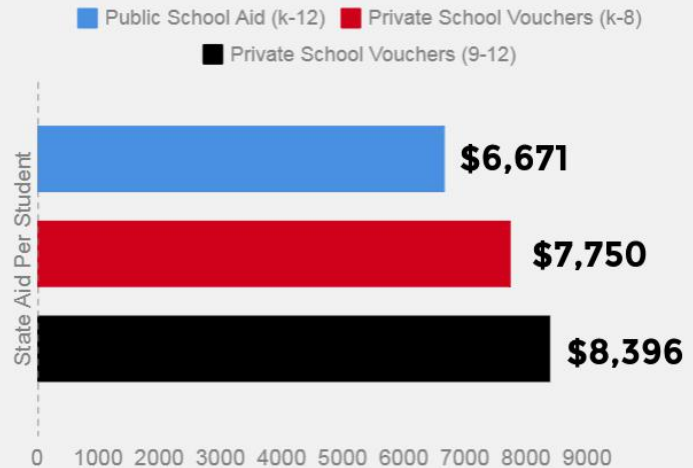
Failing Education

Failing Communities

Gov. Walker's budget fails to address issues that are important to Wisconsin families, such as:

- access to clean drinking water
- affordable childcare
- student loan debt relief

Instead, Gov. Walker's budget raids money designated for veteran nursing homes to balance his budget.
