
As an active and engaged member of our community, I always enjoy the opportunity to learn more about challenges and successes in our area.

REJECTING DEMOCRATS' EFFORTS TO EXPAND WELFARE






ENSURING HIGH QUALITY HEALTH CARE

I will continue to fight for high quality health care by **keeping** government out of your health care decisions.






