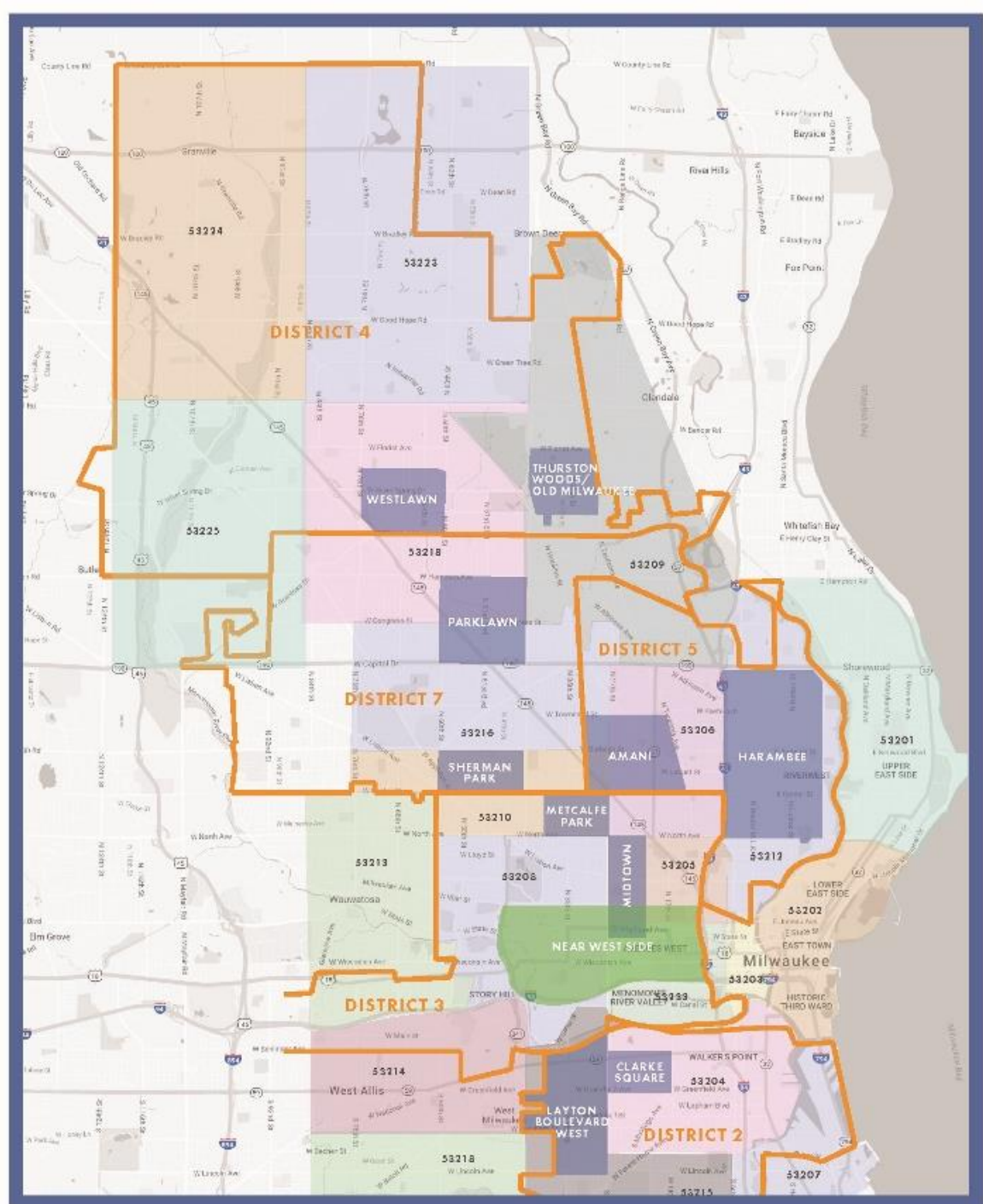

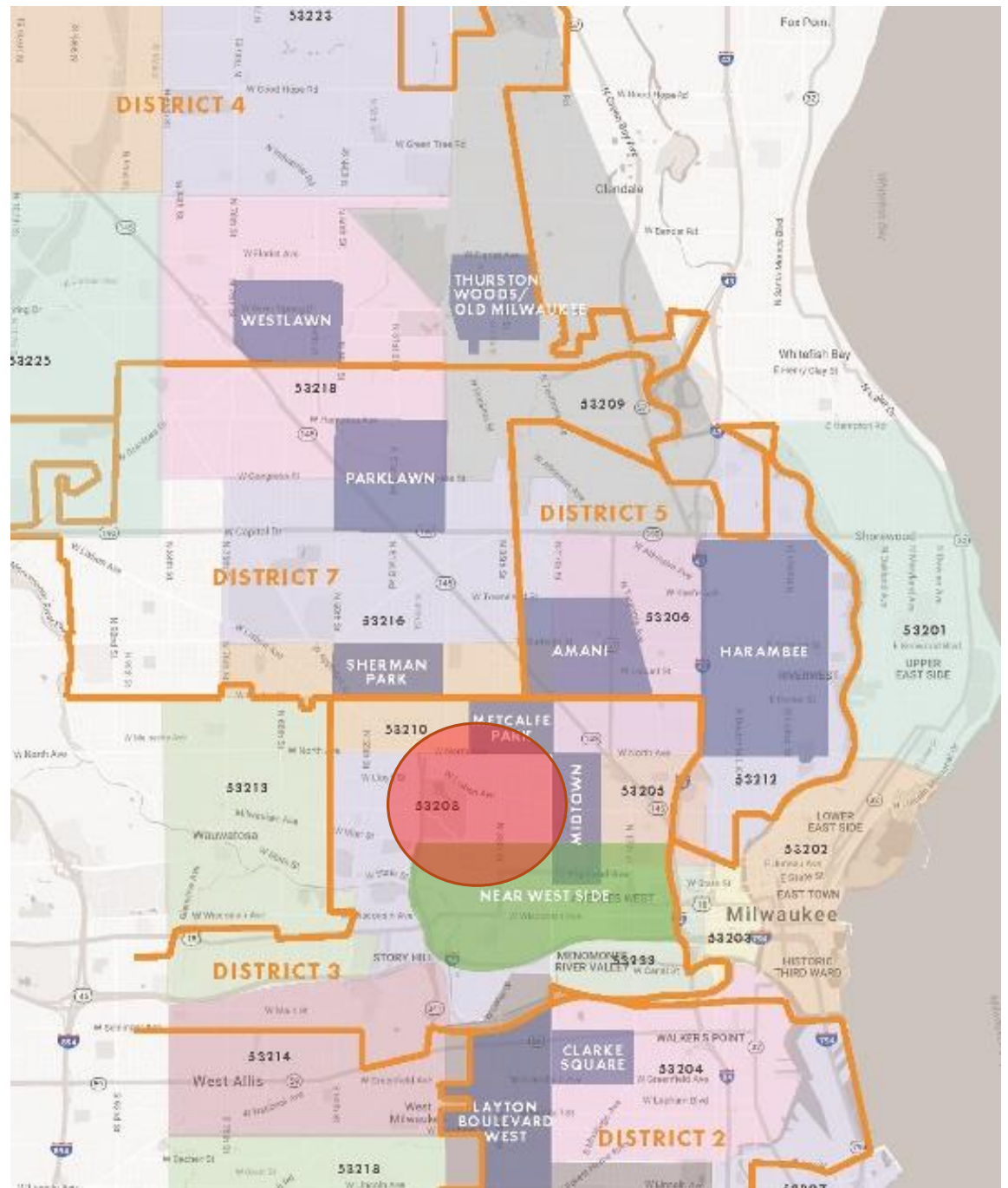

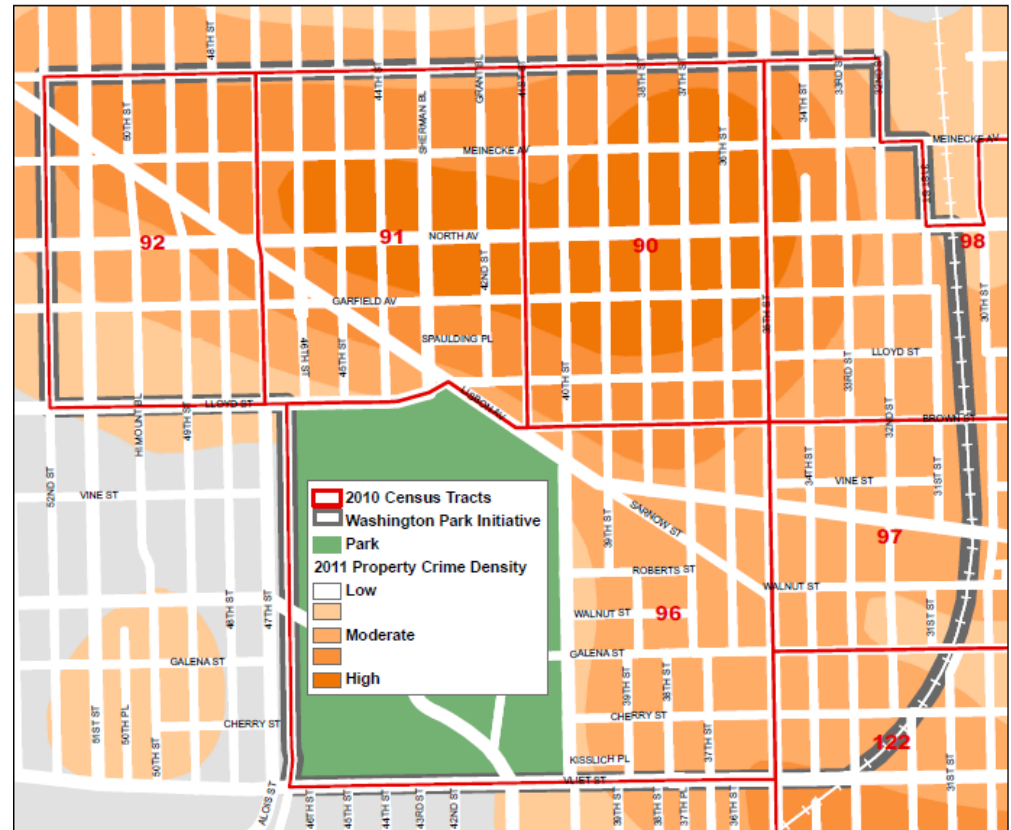

Goals

- Increase resident engagement
- Increase collective efficacy
- Increase police legitimacy

Strategies

- “Park and Walks”, increased bike and beat patrols
- Focused events on community-police relationship building
- Collaborative problem-solving approaches:
Grassroots/local/national/institutional partners
- Asset-based approach, leveraging additional partners
- Targeted Community Prosecution interventions
- Resident perception surveys

Results: Crime 2013-2015

Area	Overall Crime
City of Milwaukee	↓ 1%
Byrne Area	↓ 12%
Byrne “Hot Spots”	↓ 16%
Washington Park Neighborhood	↓ 30%
