PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

AN ACT to create 20.435 (5) (eg) and 146.643 of the statutes; relating to: grant 1

for graduate training of psychiatric nurses and making an appropriation.

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Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Health Services to award a grant in each fiscal year to an institution of higher education for its graduate program for students studying to be psychiatric mental health nurse practitioners. To receive a grant, the graduate program must commit to doing certain activities as specified in the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5	5 SECTION 2. 20.435 (5) (eg) of the statutes is created to read:		
6	20.435 (5) (eg) Graduate psychiatric nursing program grants. The amounts in		
7	the schedule for awarding a grant for a graduate program in psychiatric mental		
8	health nursing under s. 146.643.		
9	SECTION 3. 146.643 of the statutes is created to read:		
10	146.643 Grants to support graduate psychiatric nursing programs.		
11	From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (5) (eg), the department shall distribute a		
12	grant of \$250,000 in each fiscal year to an institution of higher education for its		
13	graduate program in psychiatric mental heath nursing. To receive a grant under this		
14	section the graduate program shall commit to doing all of the following:		
15	(1) Expanding the number of students studying to be board eligible psychiatric		
16	mental health nurse practitioners.		
17	(2) For students benefitting from the grant moneys under this section,		
18	requiring the students to commit to passing applicable board certification and to		
19	practicing in this state for at least 2 years after graduation from the program.		
20	(3) Expanding the instructional capacity available to teach psychiatric mental		
21	health nursing.		

(4) Providing fellowships for psychiatric mental health nursing students to
participate in clinical rotations in rural communities or areas with shortages of
mental health professionals in this state.
