PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1	AN ACT to create 165.85 (4) (em) and 256.12 (9) of the statutes; relating to:
2	standards for law enforcement officers and emergency medical services
3	personnel to use when encountering incidents involving fentanyl or opioid
4	intoxication.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Law Enforcement Standards Board and the Department of Health Services to develop training protocols and best practices for law enforcement officers to use when they encounter an incident involving fentanyl or opioid intoxication. Similarly, the bill also requires DHS to develop training protocols and best practices for emergency medical services practitioners and emergency medical responders to use when they encounter an incident involving fentanyl or opioid intoxication.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** 165.85 (4) (em) of the statutes is created to read:
- 6 165.85 (4) (em) Encounters with incidents involving fentanyl and opioids. The
- 7 board shall work with the department of health services to develop training protocols

1	and best practices for law enforcement officers to use when they encounter an
2	incident involving fentanyl or opioid intoxication.

3 **SECTION 2.** 256.12 (9) of the statutes is created to read:

4 256.12 (9) OPIOID AND FENTANYL BEST PRACTICES. The department shall develop 5 training protocols and best practices for emergency medical services practitioners 6 and emergency medical responders to use when they encounter an incident involving 7 fentanyl or opioid intoxication.
