PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 961.473 of the statutes; **relating to:** victim impact panels.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill allows a court to order a person who is found guilty of a violation of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act to attend a victim impact panel as a part of his or her sentence.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 1.** 961.473 of the statutes is created to read:

3 **961.473 Victim impact panels.** If a person pleads guilty to or is found guilty
4 of a violation of this chapter, the court may order the person to attend a victim impact
5 panel in addition to any forfeiture or penalty imposed. The court may order the
6 defendant to pay a reasonable fee, based on the person's ability to pay, to offset the
7 costs of assembling and holding the victim impact panel ordered under this section.
