Boys and Girls Club of America

Motion:

Move to provide an additional \$75,000 annually for grants to the Wisconsin Chapter of the Boys and Girls Club of America to fund programs that improve social, academic, and employment skills of youth who are eligible to receive assistance under the federal temporary assistance for needy families (TANF) program, focusing on study habits, intensive tutoring in math and English, and exposure to career options and role models. Require DCF to award grants of up to \$75,000 to the Green Bay Boys and Girls Clubs for the BE GREAT: Graduate program on a one-to-one matching basis in each year, to be used only for activities for which federal TANF block grant moneys may be used.

Note:

This motion would provide an additional \$75,000 FED annually for grants to the Boys and Girls Club of America for a total amount of \$1,175,000 FED per year. The source of the funding is the federal TANF block grant. The motion would also allocate up to \$75,000 of this funding for the Green Bay Boys and Girls Clubs BE GREAT: Graduate program. The motion would require DCF to provide this grant only to the extent that the Green Bay Boys and Girls Clubs provide matching funds. If the Green Bay Boys and Girls Clubs provide less than \$75,000 in either 2015-16 or 2016-17, the requirement to award the grant would be limited to the amount of matching funds provided. In such case, DCF would retain the shortfall for the purposes of providing grants to the Wisconsin Chapter of the Boys and Girls Club of America, including the Green Bay Boys and Girls Clubs.
