Statement on Senator Dale Kooyenga Not Seeking Reelection

MADISON – Senate Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu (R-Oostburg) issued the following statement regarding the announcement that Senator Dale Kooyenga (R-Brookfield) will not seek reelection to the State Senate after 12 years of state service:

"Dale will be missed. He has been an integral member of the Republican Caucus and a champion for taxpayers. When Dale talked about tax policy, everyone listened.
