Rep. Jonathan Brostoff sworn in to State Legislature

MADISON – Today Rep. Jonathan Brostoff (D-19) was sworn in as a State Representative for the 102nd Wisconsin State Legislature. Rep. Brostoff was officially welcomed to the legislature at an Inauguration ceremony in the State Capitol.

“It is my great honor to represent the people of the 19th Assembly District,” Rep. Brostoff said. “I look forward to rolling up my sleeves as we work to create a fair economy for all. Supporting public education and our underserved communities must be a top priority as we confront our shared challenges and opportunities.”

Rep. Brostoff will serve on the Aging and Long-Term Care, Financial Institutions, Mental Health, State Affairs and Government Operations, and Ways and Means Committees in the 2015-16 Legislative Session.

Rep. Brostoff is native to Milwaukee’s east side where he still lives today. He attended UW-Milwaukee where he earned his degree in political science and met his wife Diana Brostoff.
