When asked to rank in order the top issues facing the state of Wisconsin, these were the results (1=most important):


1. Education

- Increase transparency and address government corruption


Which policies do you support to address the epidemic of gun violence?

- No Action Needed (4%)




Which statement describes your thoughts regarding climate change?

- I do not worry about climate change (10%)




When someone gets a driver's license or state ID at the DMV, should they be automatically registered to vote?

- Undecided (3%)




Should Wisconsin legalize raw milk?

- Undecided (34%)




Should Wisconsin remove the personal exemption for vaccinations?
