## Joint Select Committee on Common Core Standards Hearing Statistics

Legislators on the select committees were able to hear over 30 hours of testimony on Common Core Standards.

In these four public hearings we heard from a total of 767 individuals and groups. The statistics are as follows:

- Appearance (speaking) for: 131 (17%)
- Appearance (speaking) against: 98 (13%)
- Registration for: 198 (26%)
- Registration against: 330 (43%)
- Information only: 10 (1%)

If combined, the “fors” and “againsts” total is:

- For Common Core Standards: 329 (43%)
- Against Common Core Standards: 428 (56%)

A final committee report will be released in the coming months as the members continue to process the information and testimony shared.
