Requirement for Pharmacists and Pharmacies to Update Immunization Registry
[LFB Summary: Page 243, #8]

Motion:

Move to modify the bill to increase, from 24 hours to seven days, the time a pharmacist or pharmacy would have to update the Wisconsin immunization registry after administering a vaccine in accordance with the state immunization program to a person six to 18 years of age.

Note:

The bill would require pharmacists and pharmacies to update the Wisconsin immunization registry for vaccines administered to children between ages six and 18 within 24 hours of administering the vaccine. The motion would extend this deadline to seven days. There is no statute or rule that requires providers to report vaccines to the registry within a certain timeframe.
