100th Anniversary of the State Capitol

Motion:

Move to require the Joint Committee on Legislative Organization to appoint a 100th Anniversary State Capitol Commemoration Commission composed of nine members, with one member each nominated by the: (a) Speaker of the Assembly; (b) Minority Leader of the Assembly; (c) President of the Senate; (d) Senate Minority Leader; (e) Governor; (f) Supreme Court; (g) Secretary of the Department of Administration; (h) State Capitol and Executive Residence Board; and (i) Director of the State Historical Society. Provide that members of the Commission would elect the Commission Chair. Direct the 100th Anniversary State Capitol Commemoration Commission to plan for events, including educational programs for children and students, to be held in 2017 commemorating the 100th anniversary of the completion of the Capitol. Provide that the Commission may request individuals and entities with knowledge of the history, construction and renovation of the Capitol to assist the Commission in its planning and execution of the commemoration.
