

ADMINISTRATION -- GENERAL AGENCY PROVISIONS

Agency Biennial Budget Requests

Motion:

Move to require that, beginning with 2017-19 budget submissions, state agencies submit biennial budget requests that contain no net increase in GPR expenditures. Further, move to require that state agencies apply a zero-based budgeting approach in developing agency biennial budget requests.

---

Note:

State agencies are required to submit to the Governor a biennial budget request for the agency no later than September 15 of each even-numbered year. Currently, the State Budget Office issues budget instructions for agencies to follow in preparing agency biennial budget requests.

Zero-based budgeting is an approach to budgetary decision-making that evaluates not only new or reestimated budget items, but also requires an agency to request and justify base resources.
