2011 BILL

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 13.086 of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting a vote on bills
2 during the first 21 days after introduction.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, no house of the legislature may vote on passage of a bill until 21 days after the bill's introduction, unless two-thirds of the members elected to that house vote to suspend the 21-day waiting period.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 13.086 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **13.086 Waiting period to vote on bills.** No house of the legislature may vote
5 on passage of a bill until 21 days after the bill's introduction, unless two-thirds of the
6 members elected to that house vote to suspend the waiting period described under
7 this section.
