2011 BILL

1	AN ACT to repeal 108.02 (26m) and 108.04 (3) of the statutes; relating to:
2	deletion of the waiting period for collection of unemployment insurance
3	benefits.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, effective for any claimant establishing an unemployment insurance benefit claim after December 31, 2011, the claimant must wait one week after becoming eligible to receive benefits before the claimant may receive benefits for a week of unemployment. The waiting period does not affect the maximum number of weeks of a claimant's benefit eligibility.

This bill deletes the one-week waiting period, thus permitting a claimant to receive benefits beginning with the first week of eligibility.

SECTION 1. 108.02 (26m) of the statutes, as created by 2011 Wisconsin Act 32,

SECTION 3. Initial applicability.
