

**TRIBAL SCHOOL BILL  
AB-637**

1. Can ask city clerk to conduct voter registration.
2. Can be on DPI Council on Special Education
3. DOA could negotiate with private vendors for computers.
4. Exempt school bus from state park sticker requirements.
5. DNR can provide trees for Arbor Day plantings.
6. Prohibits hunting within 1700 feet of school.
7. DNR can assist with boating safety courses.
8. UW could provide info on school safety.
9. Best tribal high school graduate could be in scholar program.
10. DHFS can share confidential CHIPS info.
11. DHFS can provide alcoholism information.
12. Teaching in an Indian school counts toward teaching experience.
13. Tribal school could offer DOT type driver education courses.
14. Adds tribal schools to school breakfast, lunch program.
15. DPI can assist with suicide prevention programs.
16. CESA may assist the way it assists private schools.
17. School warning signs would need to be placed by local government.
18. Tribal schools would be represented on county truancy committee.
19. Tribal schools could request info on those on sex offender registry.
20. Person can be charged for drugs within 1000 feet of tribal school.
21. Law enforcement can provide confidential info to tribal officials.
