NOTE TO THE PRESS:

The legislative reference library has begun a new series of reports called "Wisconsin Facts". They are one page mimeographed sheets supplying the answers to recurring questions about the state. This purpose is to provide a readily accessible answer in mimeographed form to questions which are repeated time after time, and for which a prepared answer does not otherwise exist. To date 5 of them have been prepared on the following subjects:

- WF 101 - 1950 population of counties and 20 major cities
- 102 - Basic data on Wisconsin industries
- 103 - Basic data on Wisconsin governors
- 104 - Area and population of Wisconsin counties
- 105 - Political composition of Wisconsin legislatures  
1885-1951

They are available in the library on request. We welcome suggestions for additional subjects which you feel might be treated in similar manner. The ultimate goal is to incorporate some of these into the expanded section on basic data on Wisconsin which is included in the 1952 Blue Book in order to develop a veritable Wisconsin World Almanac in that part of the Blue Book.
