The Legislative Technology Services Bureau (LTSB) provides information technology services and support for the Wisconsin Legislature. LTSB is a **nonpartisan** legislative service agency located on the Capitol Square in downtown Madison, Wisconsin. We provide an innovative and cooperative atmosphere with many opportunities for professional growth.

The LTSB is accepting applications to recruit a skilled and enthusiastic *Software Developer/System Analyst* on its Software Developer Team. Salary is dependent on experience and qualifications.

Position Description

We're looking for a developer to join the Publishing group of the Software Development Team. This group is responsible for designing, developing, and supporting applications and tools used to publish the documents generated by the Wisconsin Legislature and make them searchable and accessible.

As a member of the Publishers group, you will help maintain and design the Legislature's website and its documents (<https://docs.legis.wisconsin.gov>). The systems involved are in-house .NET code written in a mix of F#, C#, and VB. These tools publish documents written by users in Word, QuickSilver, and other formats to a centralized system built on top of Apache Solr. You will be directly involved in improving the website and the machinery behind it, making it more useful to the Legislature and the people of Wisconsin.

We are seeking candidates who are legally authorized to work in the United States and will not require employer visa sponsorship now or in the future. A background check will be conducted on any finalist prior to an offer of employment.
