

Moving Forward with Accounting Bill

Last week the Assembly passed my bill relating to the notice and degree requirements for the examination to practice as a certified public accountant. AB 20, which will now be taken up in the Senate, aims to broaden the number of qualified higher institutions by including any that are accredited by a Department of Education recognized accrediting agency, and simplifies the notification process, requiring the board to give public notice once, at least 30 days before the date of the next exam. I am confident that these changes will prove beneficial to our state!
